- INFORMAL AND EXPERIENCE-BASED LEARNING



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SYSTEMATIC APPROACH

- understanding that individuals are embedded in a social context tinged by power structures
- focusing on relationships, for example between "youth worker" and "target group"
- including reflexivity over one's relation to the target group

NON-FORMAL LEARNING

- learning from each others real working experiences
- visualising the issues which are handled through different tools
- combining theoretical learning with systemic work and theatre
- learning through creative tools

INTERSECTIONAL LEARNING

- understanding that power structures and oppression overlap and coexist
- exploring how to apply intersectional methods into social work and projects

THEATRE OF THE OPPRESSED

- a method developed in the 1970's in Brazil
- aims to deconstruct systemic social inequalities based on the experiences and perspectives of marginalised groups
- invites participants to physically join the stage, broadening their role from spectators to spectactors.





WHO GAN PARTICIPATE?

WHO IS A YOUTH WORKER?

• You are a youth worker if you have been working directly with young people for at least 6 months

YOU SHOULD ALSO:

- Be at least 18 years old
- have experience in working with youth from different social backgrounds
- Be willing to reflect upon local and global power structures, as well as your role in reproducing them
- Be a resident in one of the countries seen in the table to the right

GOSTS AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

- participants contribute €50 for each course week they attend.
 This is to be paid upon arrival.
- Accommodation, food and training materials are provided.
- Travel reimbursement is provided for both of the course weeks up to the limits set by the Erasmus+ Programme. The limits depend on your country of residence and can be seen on the next two pages.

WHEN AND WHERE?

• The course venue is located in Österfärnebo, north of Stockholm.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

- You will be reimbursed for your ticket to and from Sweden - up to the limits which are seen in the table to the right.
- We will arrange joint transportation to and from the venue: departure from Stockholm Central Station on the 20th of March. Participants will receive more information about this in the weeks prior to the TC.

PRACTICALS

- You will be staying at Färnebo Folkhögskola in two different houses where you will be divided into shared rooms in groups of 2 or 3.
- In the 2 houses there are 2 shared bathroom facilities per house.
- Meals will be provided 3 times per day in addition to some light refreshments in between sessions.
