Based in Sweden and Iraqi-Kurdistan, with pro-bono offices in UAE, Switzerland, the UK, USA, the Netherlands, and Hong Kong, we are a dedicated global team of staff, volunteers, partners and community members motivated by our shared vision. The story of our founder and CEO, Dr. Mariwan Baker, who himself is a former refugee, inspires us to work with respect and empathy at the heart of everything we do.

## **Ongoing Programmes**



Our programmes run on-the-ground in **Iraqi-Kurdistan**, where we work **collaboratively with the communities** we serve to facilitate projects under our five focus areas.

#### **Selected programmes:**

#### **Heart of Hope**

Children living in refugee camps with congenital cardiovascular conditions receive crucial heart surgery, including transportation to international treatment providers.

#### **Sewing Hope**

Skills-building workshops and sustained employment for women to participate in production of traditional textiles items, engendering self-esteem and empowerment

#### **Bring Hope Energy**

Sustainable and safe energy solutions delivered to refugee camp households through our partnership with WakaWaka, enabling continual sources of light for families.

#### **Bring Hope Healing**

Discussion groups, yoga, and therapy sessions to empower those we serve, improving their mental wellbeing by addressing loss, trauma, alienation, and depression.

## **Aid Donations**



Through our donation, logistics, and distribution partners (including our principal partner Johnson&Johnson UAE), we mobilise tonnes of humanitarian, hygiene, and medical aid products to be sent to the communities we serve to address basic needs and urgent crisis situations. In 2020, during the first-wave of the Covid-19 pandemic, we were proud to have delivered more than 2.1m hygiene and medical aid items across the globe.

## **Our Innovative Model**

Through our robust network of logistics, donation, institutional, and distribution partners, we mobilise products to donate and ensure smooth transportation and delivery to the communities we support.



#### Local

Our we work **collaboratively** with active participation with the communities we serve, mobilising vital expertise and facilitating **local empowerment**. We recognise the staying power that local, **grassroots organisations** have within communities, and acknowledge the long-lasting commitment to local issues that comes from community-embedded organisations.

#### Accountable

Our partnerships drive our strong commitment to accountability and transparency in all aspects of our work. We are held to the highest possible standard by our multi-stakeholder network who are invested in seeing their donated time and effort deliver veritable solutions. Our model is based on trust, and we strongly understand that to maintain this, we must remain accountable, transparent, and honest in collaboration with our partners.

#### **Environmental**

Our humanitarian aid products (such as hygiene items, clothes or blankets) are donated in-kind from partners, and most often come from **stock surpluses** or unsalable inventories. If these items are not distributed through Bring Hope and our partners, they would be thrown away. We **save tonnes of items** from landfill or incineration, offering donation partners a **cost-saving**, **high social impact method** for dealing with surpluses.

#### Resilient

Our model **adapts quickly** to change through our multiple channels of donation, delivery and distribution. We ensure a **rapid response** through our short chain of command and wide network of donation and logistics partners.

Our network translates easily into a wider context for distribution through continued partnership building with local, grassroots organisations.

### **Our Stories**



#### **Bring Hope and Covid-19**

As the 2020 pandemic raged, economic instability and displacement of vulnerable individuals continued and intensified. We embraced ongoing support efforts by **delivering much needed hygiene items** to Africa and the Middle East. 35 shipping containers brought over **two million hygiene items** to those we serve, at a time when many other organisations were forced to stop their operations due to pandemic conditions. Our donations reached **more than 500,000** refugees, internally displaced people, and those in extreme poverty, who received safety net hygiene items to enhance their wellbeing.



#### **Staish's Story**

Staish, a three year-old girl from Iraqi-Kurdistan, is now growing up safe and healthy. Born with only half of her heart, her condition meant that she had difficulty breathing, alongside many other health problems. Like many others in the region, her family struggled with financial support for her crucial surgery. With the help of our partners, we sent Staish and her family to India for her lifesaving and successful heart surgery.



## **Principal Partners**

Our collaborative partnerships are the **pillar of our** successes as an organization. Bring Hope's global **network** of local and international partner organizations is how we ensure continued delivery of our essential aid donations, as well as facilitate our projects on the ground.
