### HOW IT STARTED

It all started more than two decades ago when Dr. Ghassan Hanna, began tackling, researching, developing long lasting engaging programs towards greater equality, no discrimination, and no prejudices against people with special needs. He lost his eye sight at the age of 21. It was a life changing event that inspired him to move with a broader and more comprehensive vision with the aim of serving humanitarian issues in general, de-

fending and demanding the realization of human rights and people with disabilities in particular. Dynamic and seasoned experts joined Dr. Hanna, and together they founded on February 2023 " Cedars Phoenix (Alpha to Omega).

- Segments that have influence in society, political life, and public affairs

- Developing all public and private facilities




