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STORY

A typewriter (daktilo in Turkish) is a writing machine and it leaves a mark. Typwriters were treated as "dangerous weapons" that had to be monitored and recorded for authoritarian governments until the invention of computers.



In 1983 with a law enacted in Romania, owning a typewriter was only possible with the permission of the police force. Citizens were required to get registered with the unique characteristics of their machines so that authorities could detect the writer when a political text was released. Moreover, it was forbidden for individuals to sell their typewriters to each other. In the case of lending, the responsibility belonged to the citizen registered with the police force.

The tension between intelligence officers and intellectuals during the Cold War presented us the movie Das Leben Der Anderen. It's time to show the solidarity that European intellectuals showed in 1984.

It is time to reveal and defend the relationship between freedom of mind, thought and dignified life. This is why Daktilo 1984 was established.

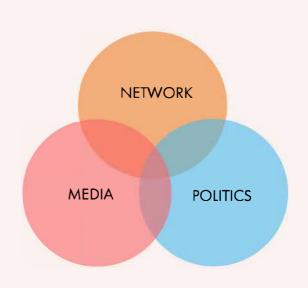

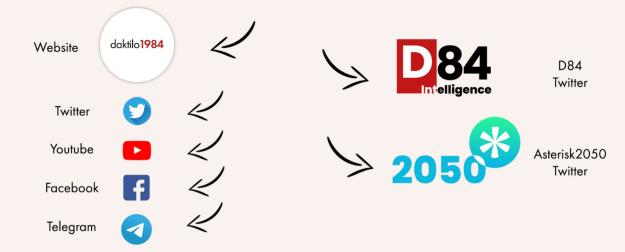
